Nutrition and Chemistry:

The chemistry indicator is a component of Contact Reflex Analysis as developed by Dr. Dick Versandaal. This reflex is in the belly of the right cheek as well as the right second rib space. The patient may contact these points followed by the RAMTR.

Once found active however, the reflex should be pulsed or scored in determining a specific number.

- Any number pulsed above 10 is indicative of poisoning, toxicity in the body and appropriate nutrition is given.
- Anything less than a 10 is indicative of specific nutrition as relating to CRA procedures.

The nutrition reflex as relating to Davis Advanced Health System is contacted by the patient by placing their left thumb at a point where there is an indentation area as the left clavicle meets the sternum. This is right below acupuncture K27. The patient's left index finger touches the right indentation area and the RAMTR is performed and evaluated for weakness. This reflex is related to Lumbar 2 right and relates to the patient being in fight/flight response with Cranial-Dural-Sacral torque. (See Page 37 for full description)

Stomach Malabsorption and Toxic Gut:

The doctor may choose also to evaluate stomach malabsorption and toxic gut at this time. This procedure again is from Contact Reflex Analysis and if present, is vital to clear in the patient as their ability to respond to care and get well is crucial if this is not cleared up.

The procedure is to have the patient sit in a chair, or on the adjusting table with arms outstretched, fingers of both hands interlocked (making a fist). This represents the heart and all its backups. The doctor then proceeds to pulse the outstretched hands of the patient, asking the patient to resist downward pressure trying not to overpower the doctor.

- Any drop of the arm at a seven to ten is respectable and not an indicator for malabsorption.
- Anything less than a pulse of seven indicates **malabsorption**. Nutritionally, this is an indicator for Vitamin B12, although other physical, mental, and spiritual factors may be the cause.
- If the pulsed number is above seven, indicating **toxic stomach** the doctor may proceed to evaluate where the body is being affecting.



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- The patient continues to sit with outstretched arms. The doctor instructs patient to rotate head left, and then applies downward pressure on both arms. If weakness, this is indicative that gut toxicity has ***affected the immune system.***
- Next, patient *tips head backwards*. Weakness here denotes ***toxicity to the back of brain and brain stem.***
- *Rotation of head to the right* with weakness ***denotes toxicity affecting the endocrine system and hormones.***
- *Head is flexed forward*. Weakness denotes ***toxicity of the autonomic, central nervous system.***

Again, CRA has a nutritional protocol for Toxic Gut, but in the Davis Advanced Health System, other factors may possibly be the cause.
